## Supplies:

Paper trimmer with scorer, scissors, stamps, ink, card stock, patterned Designer Series Paper, Multipurpose Liquid Glue and any embellishments.

For this tutorial, I used the following supplies (but you can use anything you wish):

- Bird's Eye View stamp set #161436
- Box Bubble Bath card stock
- Card Bases: Pool Party, Azure Afternoon, Fresh Freesia, Lemon Lolly, Petal Pink & Flirty Flamingo
- Lighter than Air Designer Series Paper #162747
- Memento Black Ink
- · Various colored Blends Markers
- Basic White 3" x 3" Envelopes #159233

## Directions for 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" Gift Box



Box Base: 9-1/2" x 5-1/4" Score: 1", 4-1/4", 5-1/4" & 8-1/2"



Belly Band: 9-1/2" x 1-1/2" Score: 1", 2-1/8", 5-1/2" & 6-5/8" (You can make yours any width)




Flip Base to Portrait Position & score 1" on both sides.



Decorative Papers:
Box front & inside - 3" x 3"
Belly Band - 3" x 1-1/4"





Cut all side score lines until it meets the vertical 1" score line. Fold on all score lines.



Adhere patterned paper to front top of box base.



Flip over & adhere to inside top.



Fold center tabs inwards & apply glue. Attach center tabs to bottom sides.



Repeat with bottom.








Repeat with top of box.






Adhere patterned paper on top of belly band. Fold on score lines.



Wrap band around closed box.



Apply glue on side edge.







Decorate your cards however you wish!

Card Bases: 6" x 3", scored at 3" Patterned paper 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"
